Craigencalt Rural Community Trust is a charity committed to managing and improving the environment of Kinghorn Loch and the surrounding land through practical and valued projects. CRCT brings together nature lovers, landowners, residents, walkers and groups that use the loch and landward area to work together for the benefit of all. As such, the Trust comprises those with a love of the area and encourages visitors to enjoy it in a fully sustainable manner. With the loch water now in excellent condition, there are great opportunities for watersports, recreation, enterprise and education to exist side by side, supporting each other.

The Trust is formed entirely of volunteers. Projects such as new pathways, information boards, jetty and access improvements, nesting platforms and path maintenance are guided by an informal group to help co-ordinate and manage facilities. We welcome new volunteers and supporters to join us.

Each year we also organise events such as a water sports 'Come and Try Day', a Walking Festival, regular walks, indoor presentations and social gatherings. The Trust has published booklets on local pathways, birds and heritage and history.

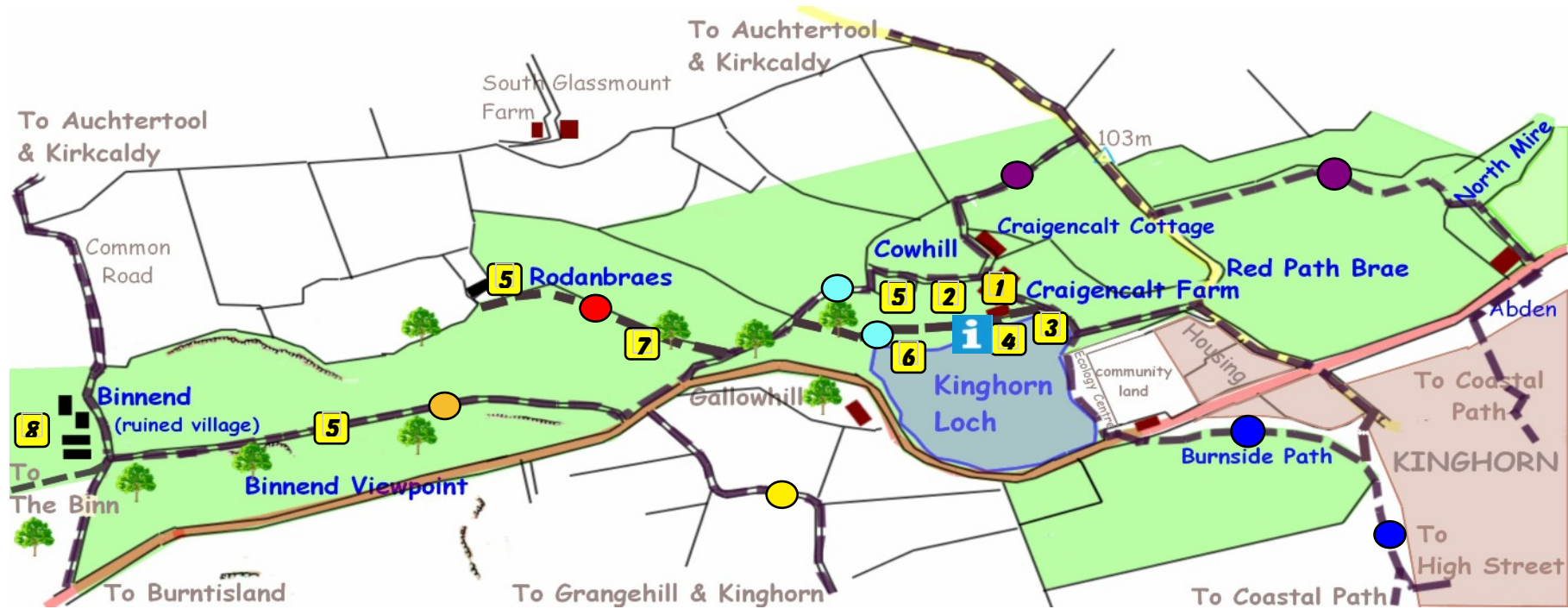
